This Sunday's Gospel (Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21) brings us two powerful moments. First, Luke explains why he's writing his Gospel—to share the truth about Jesus. Then we see Jesus Himself in the synagogue, reading from Isaiah and declaring, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

It's fitting that this is the Sunday of the Word of God because it reminds us just how alive and active Scripture is. When Jesus reads Isaiah, He isn't just looking at words on a page. He's saying, "This is happening now, and I'm the one bringing it to life."

The same is true for us. God's Word isn't just a history lesson; it's meant to speak to us today, right where we are. So, as we reflect this week, let's open our Bibles with fresh eyes, ready to hear what God is saying to us and how He's calling us to live it out.
