

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus gives us one of His toughest challenges: "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you." That's not exactly easy, is it? When someone wrongs us, our instinct is to fight back or hold a grudge. But Jesus calls us to something greater—to break the cycle of hate with love.

He goes even further: "If someone slaps you on one cheek, offer the other." He's not saying we should be pushovers, but rather that we should respond with mercy instead of revenge. When we do that, we reflect God's own love—a love that goes beyond fairness and into grace.

Then comes the Golden Rule: "Do to others as you would have them do to you." Imagine if we all lived by that! The world would look a lot different.

Let's ask God for the strength to love like Jesus—especially when it's hardest.

<u>Campaign Against Assisted Dying – Write to your MP.</u> The Leadbeater Westminster Bill, which initially included a safeguard requiring High Court judge scrutiny for each request, has now replaced this with panels. Kim Leadbeater's claim that the bill would be "the most robust legislation of its kind in the world" is now under question. Pro-life organizations are urging people to write to their MPs, who voted for the bill at Second Reading, to reconsider their position and vote against it in the third reading. Race Night Fundraiser St Mary's Primary - School Hall 7<sup>th</sup> March 6.45pm The Parent Council and school are organising a race night to raise funds for school excursions for all children this school year.
