Write to your MP

One of the things which persuaded more than a few MPs to vote for the Leadbeater Bill at second reading last November was the inclusion of a showpiece "safeguard": that each request would be scrutinised by a High Court judge.

Kim Leadbeater said in the media and during the debate that the High Court's role would make her bill "the most robust legislation of its kind in the world," and she and her allies have repeatedly insisted since that this aspect would remain despite expert warnings.

Now, that "safeguard" has collapsed; Ms Leadbeater briefed selected journalists that panels would be created instead. Can we encourage you to write to your MP, who voted for the Bill at Second Reading, asking them to reconsider their position and to either abstain or vote no when it comes back for its third reading?
