He is risen! Alleluia! Easter Sunday bursts into our lives with the radiant joy of the Resurrection. After the long journey of Lent, we now stand at the empty tomb with Mary Magdalene and the disciples, filled with wonder and hope. Death does not have the final word—Jesus is alive, and that changes everything.

Sometimes we get used to hearing this. "He is risen" can sound like just another phrase. But today, let it sink in: Jesus defeated death. Not just His death—*ours*, too. Our fears, our failures, our sins—He takes them all and transforms them with His love.

Easter is not just a day. It's a *reality* we're invited to live in. So let's rejoice, not just with songs and celebration, but with hearts wide open. Let the joy of the Resurrection shine through us today—at home, at work, wherever we are. Christ is risen indeed! Let's live like we believe it.
