**Reception of the Precious Blood** The Archbishop has confirmed that the practice of dipping the host into the chalice (Intinction) is not permitted for the lay faithful. This follows the guidelines of Redemptionis Sacramentum 104 which gives the specific details. "The communicant must not be permitted to intinct the host himself in the chalice".
